

Rodzinne Ogrody Działkowe we Wrocławiu

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Zieleń Wrocławia

- Ogólna powierzchnia wszystkich terenów zieleni wynosi 3461,7 ha + 1429 = **4890,7** ha.
- obejmował 754,08 ha terenów zielonych (bez lasów komunalnych , ogrodów działkowych i zieleni towarzyszącej budynkom mieszkalnym i przemysłowym).
- Tereny zieleni tymczasowej i nieurządzonej to 78,66 ha.
- Zieleńce, których jest 145 zajmują 116,06 ha.
- Zieleń towarzysząca ulicom rozciąga się na 499,38 ha.
- Na osiedlach mieszkaniowych zieleni 405 ha.
- Powierzchnia lasów to 2285,1 ha.
- Parki Wrocławia (**559,36** ha) , których jest 45.
- Ogrody działkowe - łączna ich powierzchnia to **1429** hektarów

Struktura ROD

- Na terenie Wrocławia w granicach administracyjnych zlokalizowanych jest 158 Rodzinnych Ogrodów Działkowych.
- Łączna ich powierzchnia to 1429 hektarów
- Największą powierzchnię 23,1619 ha zajmuje ogród przy ul Chińskiej – Krzyki,
- Najmniejszą powierzchnię ma ogród przy Ul. Gostawickiej - 1.998 ha

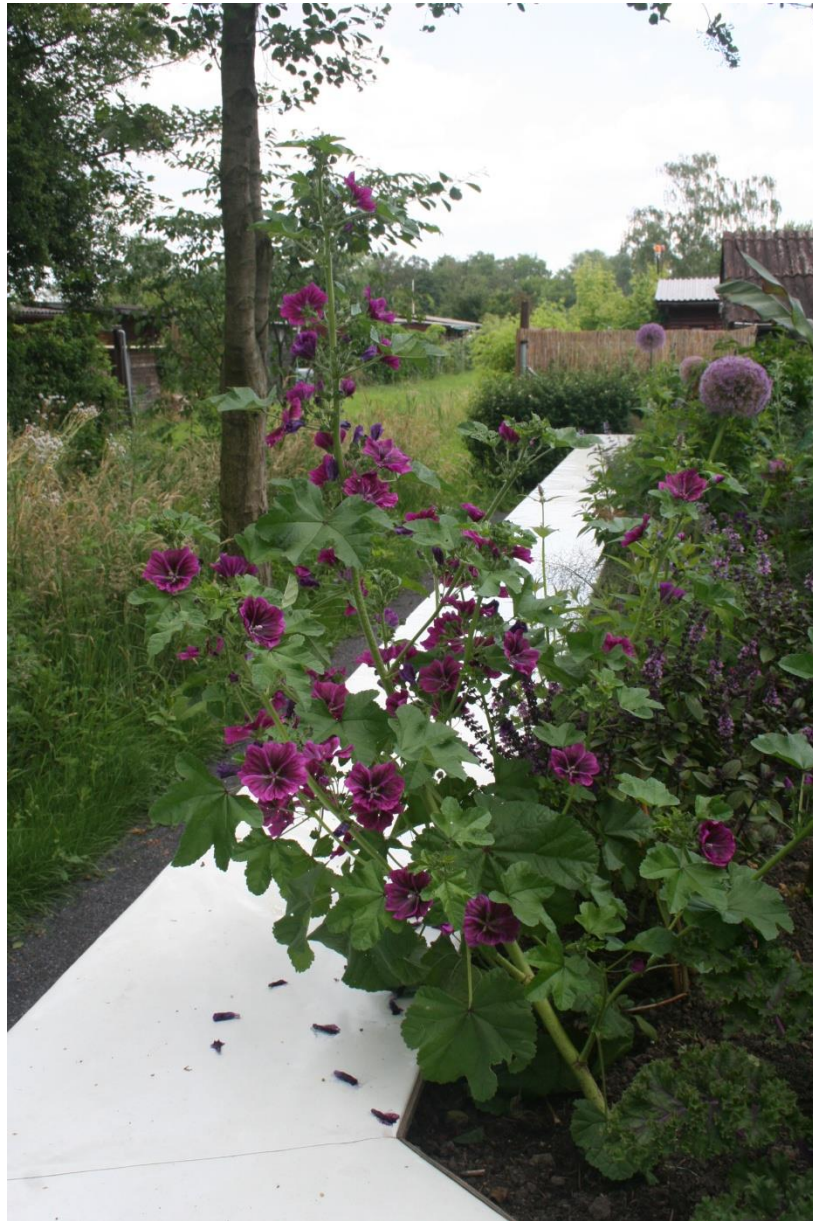

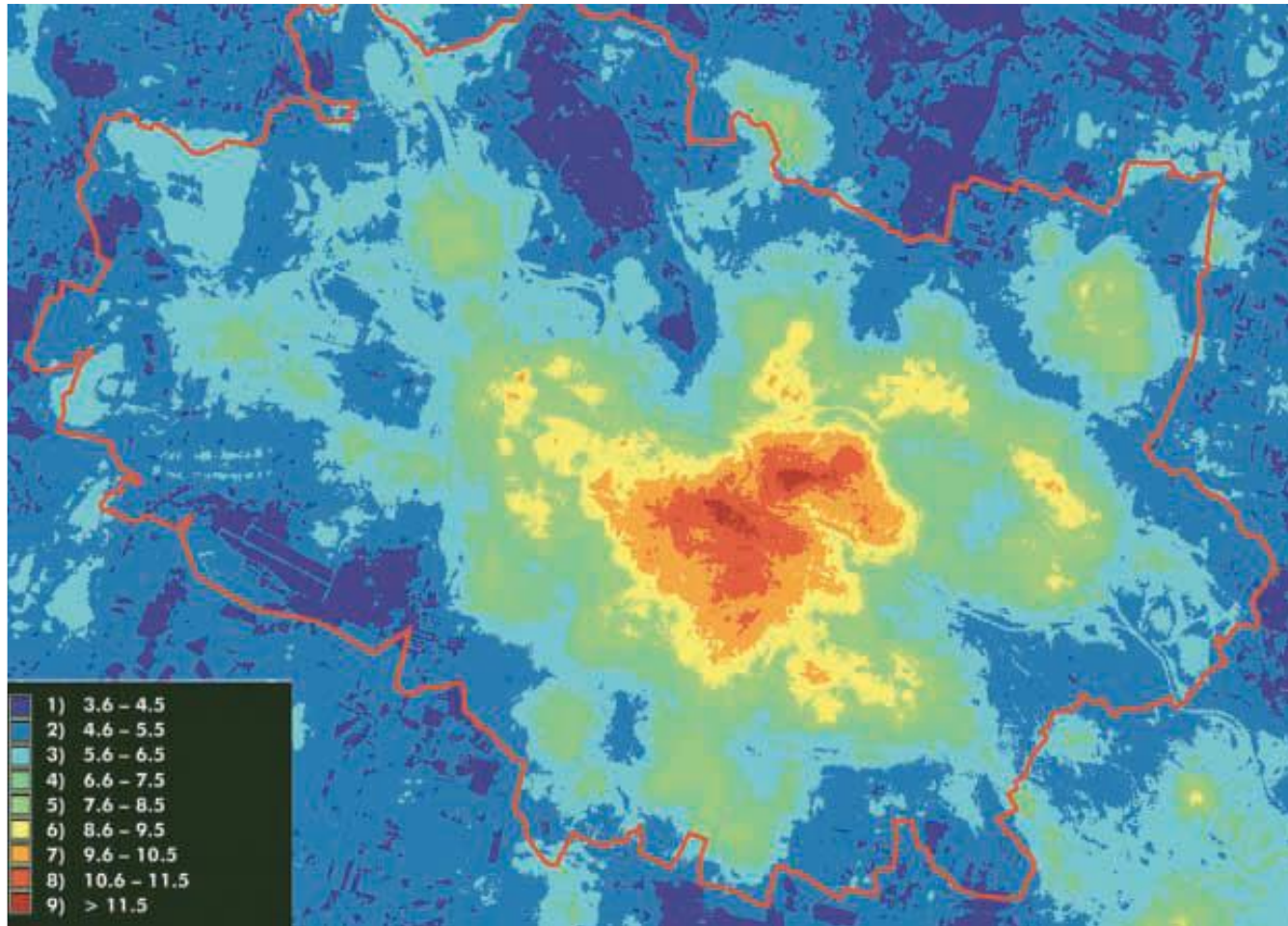

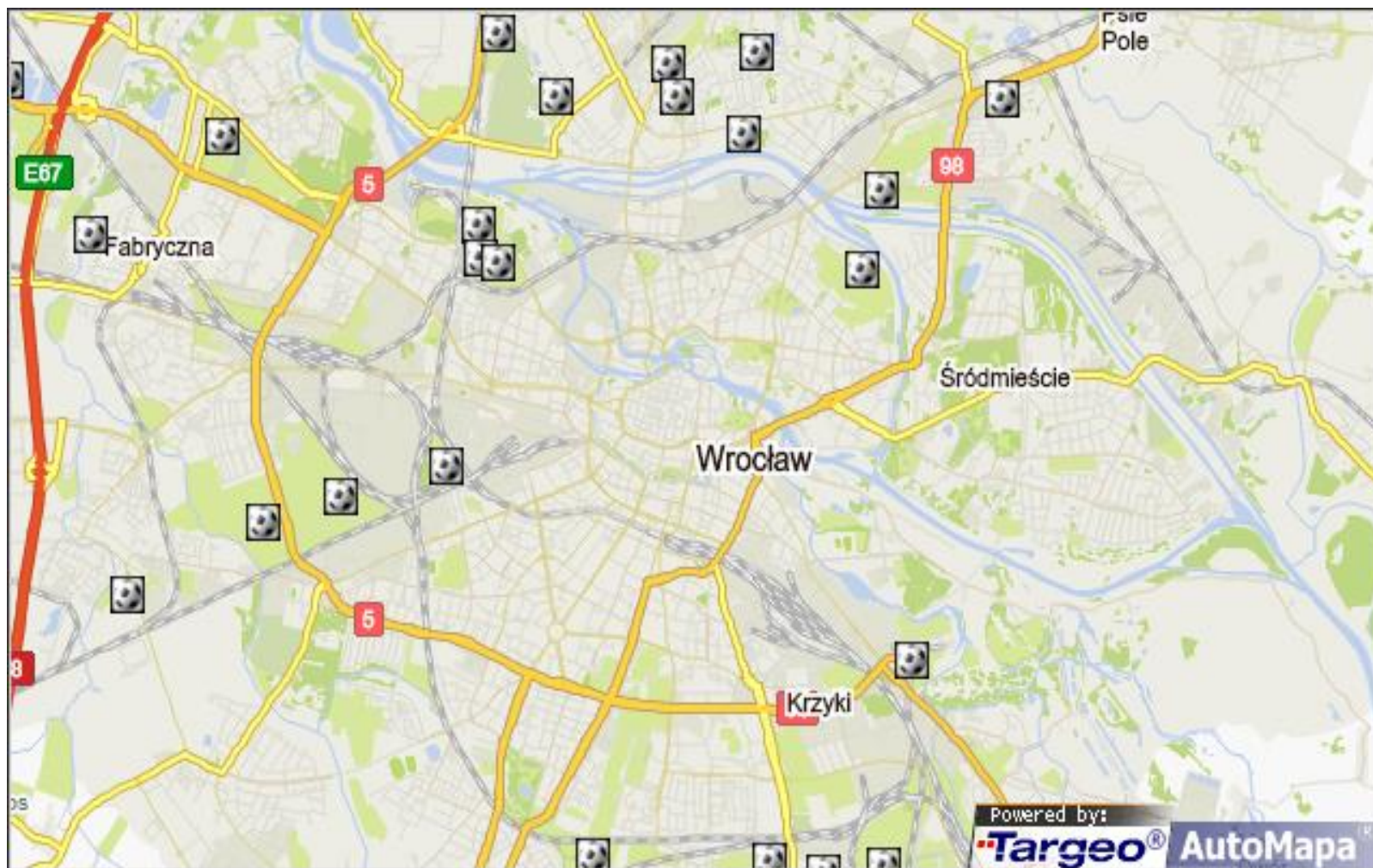




Wpływ na mikroklimat i klimat miasta

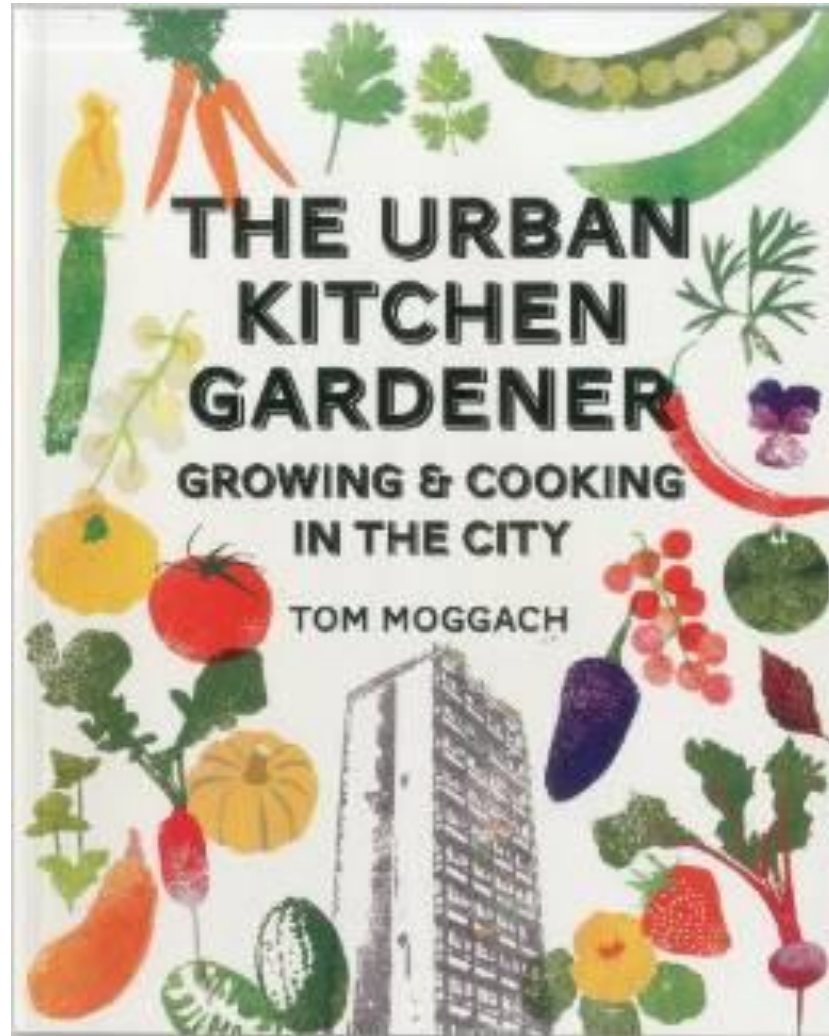
